- 4. The Red Admiral butterfly and the bee (stitched 2 over 2) are from a Marjolein Bastin design entitled "The Four Seasons"*
- 5. The calf (stitched 1 over 1) is from a Jacquelyn Fox design entitled "Little Boy Blue" published in The Needlecraft Shop's "Timeless Treasures" book*
